

The Great Rich Valley Bathtub Race

The beauties and the brawn from the Fifties and Sixties will be on display during the Great Rich Valley Bathtub Race. Having been unable to compete in the mud and rain of Drumheller certain female jockeys challenge all chapters to race in a bathtub.

Basic Rules

1. Tubs must be at least 2 feet long and 12 inches deep and may be constructed of any material.
2. Tubs may be pushed or pulled. No engines larger than 60 horsepower will be allowed,
3. Maximum of 3 persons per team and only two may push or pull or steer the tub.
4. Appropriate 50's\60's style bath or swim wear or costumes should be worn by all team members.
5. All tubs must have appropriate safety devices: oars, flotation devices, and brakes.
6. All teams must provide a short tub race history overview and short participant/pilot resumes.
