Alberta Provincial Rally Golf Rules

These are the official Provincial Golf rules which take effect commencing 2019.

Remember the purpose of the tournament is to have fun, socialize, and meet fellow Good Sam members.

- 1) The golf tournament will be by way of a “Scramble” format, as outlined below.
- 2) The tournament will consist of no more than nine (9) holes.
- 3) The golf club Pro/Manager will determine if the tournament is by a “shotgun” start, or otherwise.
- 4) Teams will consist of a maximum four (4) players.
- 5) Teams will be selected, by the tournament chairperson, and players “will be” randomly drawn, from a hat. Ladies will be drawn from a separate hat in order to have a maximum of two (2) on each team.
- 6) In the nine holes, each team must utilize at least two (2) drives from each of their players.
- 7) After determining which drive is utilized, all team players will shoot their ball from the point where that ball lands. After determining which next shoot is utilized, all players will again shoot their ball from that point. This procedure will continue until the end of the hole.
- 8) Men will drive from the “white” tees. Ladies may choose to use the “forward” tees.
- 9) Rally pins will be awarded for the first and second place team. Presentation of pins will be held at the course, after completion of the tournament.
