The Parkland Jays RV Club was established on October 20, 1997, and is very active today. To date we have 34 rigs in our club with a total of 69 members. Our main function is doing what we love best...*camping*. Through our campouts many memories and lasting friendships have developed. In the evenings, weather permitting, there is usually a campfire- some nights there might be a trivia or card game, perhaps a singalong, and often sharing stories till dark.

We are an active club with various activities throughout the year. A typical camping weekend consists of games, touring local attractions and shopping. We also encourage members to contribute to the community by visiting farmer markers, supporting local businesses in the area we are camping, and at the end of the year we recommend a donation to a local charity and/or food bank. In the evenings, weather permitting, there is usually a campfire with music, singalongs and sharing stories till after dark.

Our camping season usually begins on the May long weekend and ends after Labour Day in September. Campouts are arranged by the Wagonmaster who provides a list of all campouts for the season. Members are free to pick and choose campouts as their schedule allows. There are generally 10 - 20 campouts per year to choose from and often weekend campouts are shared with other clubs and/or special guests.

Our club meetings are usually held after the camping season ends. At this time, we will elect a new Executive and catch up on business matters. Meetings are combined with a social time and always a lunch.

The annual Christmas party, a catered affair usually is held in late November or early December.
